Headquarters	July 5, 1934	Called into active service, July 5, 1934. Accompanied by his aid Captain John W. Guerard. Assumed command of the California National Guard with Headquarters in Berkeley. On July 16 moved to Ferry Building, San Francisco. On July 18 stationed aboard S.S. Fort Sutter tied up alongside Pier 3. On July 21, reviewed all National Guard troops in San Francisco.
