Stations and Locations

The nine companies of the Sixth Infantry responded promptly to the order from Governor Pardee, dated April 19, 1906, to report to Brigadier General John A. Koster in:

San Francisco, California.

The regiment arrived in San Francisco about midnight, April twentieth. Reported to General Koster and was immediately detailed for guard and patrol duty in the district of San Francisco, west of Van Ness Avenue. The men of the Sixth Infantry did valuable service while in the field, responded promptly to all orders, and performed the arduous duties assigned to them in a soldierly manner.

Companies E, G, and I were relieved from further field duty May fifteenth and returned to their home stations
