Oakland was called into active service  
April 21, 1906,\* and stationed at:

Berkeley, California.\*\*

The duties assigned to this company were  
to perform guard duty at the refugee camps,  
guarding supplies and supply depots and  
performing other duties contributing to  
the welfare of refugees in the city of  
Berkeley. The company was relieved from  
active duty May thirteenth under Field  
Order No. 8, dated May 13, 1906†
