CRIST: That for the regiments and separate battalions of the California National Guard: On a wreath of the colors (argent and gules) the setting sum behind a griszly bear passent on a grassy field all proper.

CREST: That for the regiments and separate battelions of the Cregon Metional Guard: On a wreath of the colors (argent and gules) a demi disc gules charged with the setting sum with twelve light rays or (the shoulder sleeve insignie of the 4lst Division), behind a besive sejant proper.

MATTU: Enruest Endesvor.

DESCRIPTION

The colors red and white are for Engineers. The Hurmess stars indicate one battle honor swarded the organization for service in that area, while the Malayan bear, indigenous to burms and the Malay Peninsula, represents the other bettle bonor.

1. Reference is made to letter 421.4, your Headquarters, 17 September 1951, and to let Indorsement UMGHB 424.2 - 1905th Engr Avn Bn, this Office, 15 October 1951, above subject.

2. The design submitted is not satisfactory in that it takes the form of caricature. Designs embodying caricature or humorous approach are not considered appropriate for use in the design of a coat of arms and distinctive insignia which is used on the organizational flag and worn on the uniform of the United States Army.

3. A suggested design is forwarded for concurrence. It is described as follows:

Per bend argent and gules, in chief a Malayan bear's head affronte erased proper and in pase SHIELD: the Burmese insignia of six stars of the first.

That for the regiments and separate battalions of the CREST: California National Guard: On a wreath of the colors (argent and gules) the setting sum behind a grizzly bear passant on a grassy field all proper.

That for the regiments and separate battalions of the CREST: Oregon National Guard: On a wreath of the colors (argent and gules) a demi disc gules charged with the setting sun with twelve light rays or (the shoulder sleeve insignia of the 41st Division), behind a beaver sejant proper.

- 6. Upon receipt of concurrence by the organization in the design and return of correspondence with the design, this Office will process approvals of a coat of arms and distinctive insignia.




